Activities

1) Write a rhythm pattern, clap it, then play it on each string. For example:	
Gussie Grasshopper hops to the beach! Dora Dragonfly dreams of Alfie Ant likes to Enid Earwig eats	
2) Play all the rhythms , one after the other, to make your own piece Say "Here - we - go - and" before you begin, to keep steady time!	
3) Swap rhythms with a parent or a friend Teach each other your own rhythms (get the other person to play your rhythms back to you). Then add all the rhythms together and make another piece!	to
