## **Composition Time!**




Write a rhyme about an imaginary animal like the Kangadillo... it's a cross between a Kangaroo and an Armadillo!

Start by choosing the first half of its name from Column 1 ... then the second half from Column 2 ...

Then add <b>stems</b> and <b>beams</b> to the notes to add the right rhythm. Don't forget the <b>treble clef</b> , <b>time signature</b> , and <b>bar lines</b> !
