
The Rest Family Tree

Note Values and their Rests



Silences in music are shown by rests.

Every member of the rhythm family has his or her own rest!



The semibreve and minim rest look similar so remember these sentences:

"The $\underline{\mathbf{S}}$ emibreve $\underline{\mathbf{S}}$ wings from the $\underline{\mathbf{S}}$ econd line down."

"The Minim Meets the Middle line."

The semibreve rest is also used to show a whole bar rest.
