
F Major Scale



Key Signature: 1 Flat




F Major is a challenging key to play in because it uses Finger Pattern 2, with the 1st fingers extended back on the A and the E string. This is a new pattern. Here is the scale. The key signature has one flat, Bb.



To get used to the Finger Pattern, try playing the scale to the rhythm of the words 'Broccoli and carrots'. Finish the next 2 bars:

Activities
