
Crocodillo Snapping





Activities

- 1) Clap and say the words
- 2) **Clap** and **say** the rhythm names (e.g. quick, quick quick, quick, quick slow, quick)
- 3) Sign and sing the note names
- 4) **Play** 'air bow' for 2 bars. **Say** the time names: "short short short short, short long short, short short short short, long ssh!"
 - ... this will help you with the length of bow needed for each stroke.
- 5) Play through the piece.

♦ Snap Pizz!

If you're going to make your violin sound like a crocodile, then you are going to need to do a SNAP pizz!

When you see the **b** sign, 'pinch' the string between two fingers, and pull it upwards... but not too far, because you don't want it to snap!

Then let go, and it will 'snap' back down onto the fingerboard with a snappy sound!
