
Rhythm Bank 1

Quavers and Crotchets



Now that we know both crotchets and quavers, we can make up rhythms together! Here are some animal rhythms to clap with a friend:



Take turns to Clap, Say and Play the cat part and the mouse part!

Activities

- 1) Clap and say the rhythm names of the cat part followed by the mouse part.
- 2) Clap and say the words of the cat part, followed by the mouse part.
- 3) Ask a friend to **clap** the mouse line, while you **clap** the cat line! Then swap over. This is called a **duet**.
- 4) **Play** this as a duet one person on the cat line, and one on the mouse line. Then swap over!
