Quavers and Crotchets

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Now that we know both crotchets and quavers, we can make up rhythms together! Here are some animal rhythms to clap with a friend:



slow quick quick slow slow slow quick quick slow
Bear mon-key bear bear bear mon-key bear



slow slow quick quick quick quick slow quick quick slow quick quick
Bear bear mon-key mon-key bear mon-key bear mon-key

Take turns to **Clap, Say** and **Play** the cat part and the mouse part!

Activities

- 1) **Clap** and **say** the **rhythm** names of the cat part followed by the mouse part.
- 2) **Clap** and **say** the **words** of the cat part, followed by the mouse part.
- 3) Ask a friend to **clap** the mouse line, while you **clap** the cat line!
Then swap over. This is called a **duet**.
- 4) **Play** this as a duet - one person on the cat line, and one on the mouse line.
Then swap over!
