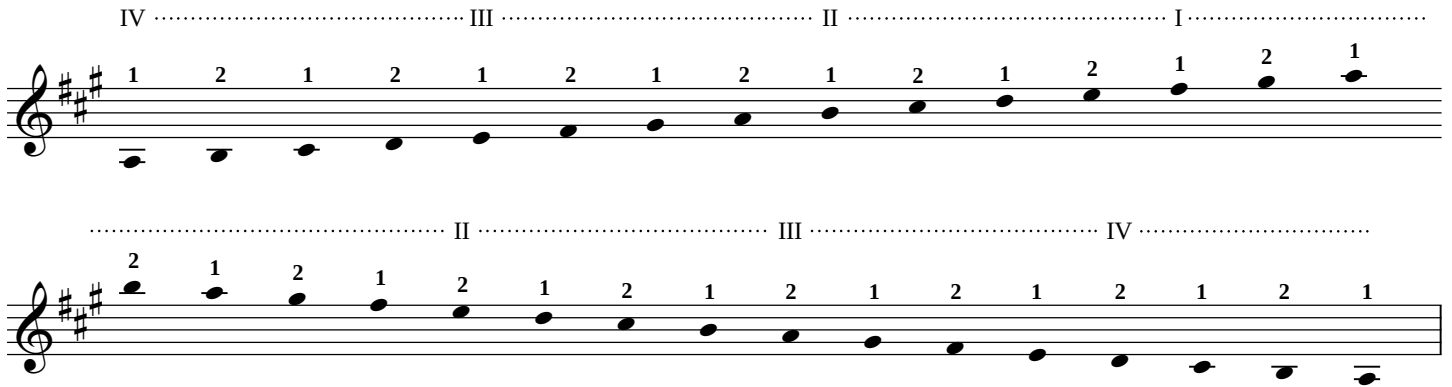
Two-Finger Scales



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A Major (1 & 2)

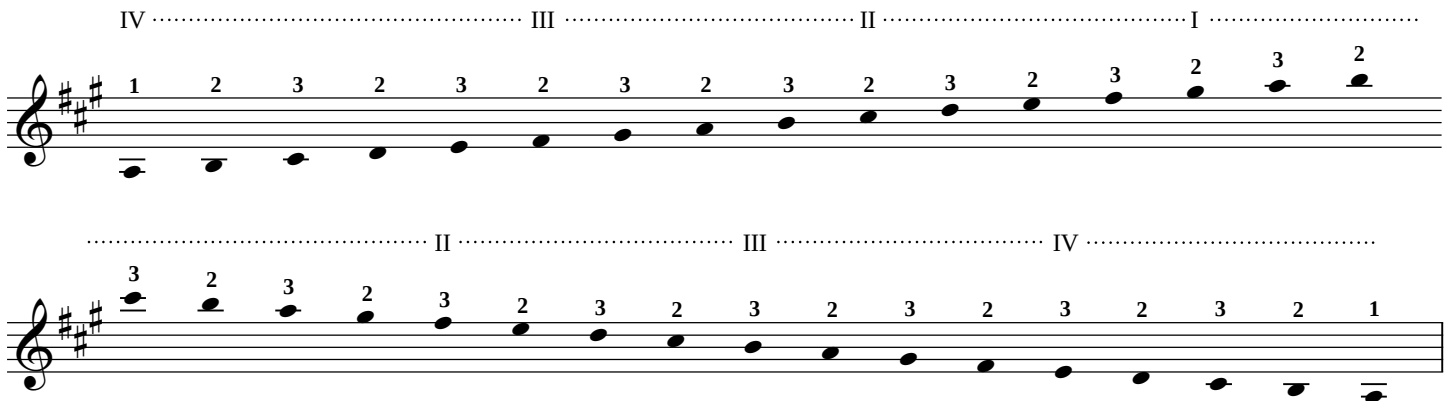

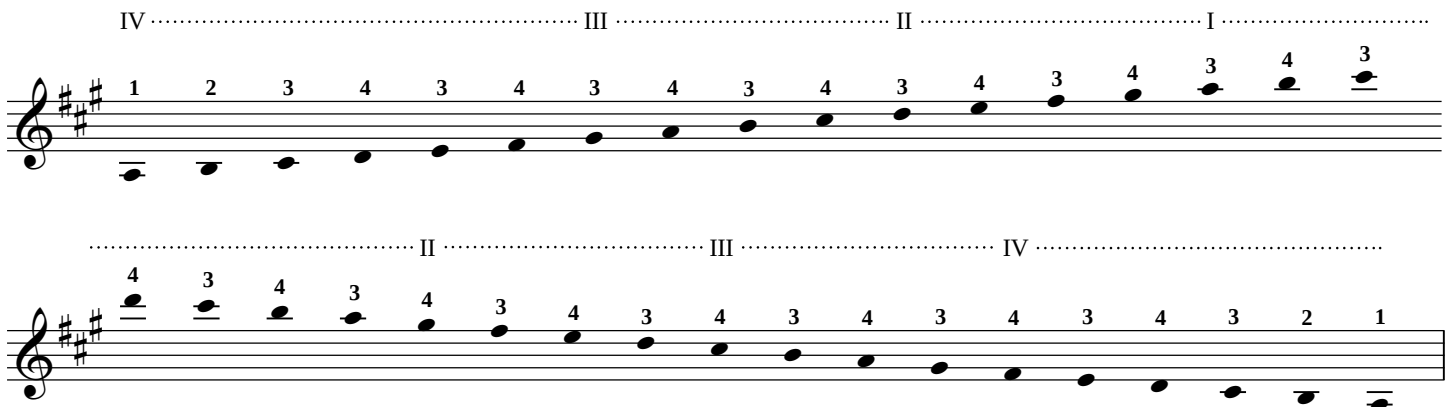
