Activities

- Answer** these questions: Which key is this piece in? What is the symbol on the final beat of the piece?
- Practise** the 'col legno' bow stroke, by bouncing the wood of the bow on your violin strings.
- Repeat** bars 7 and 8 several times. Make a clear difference between the *staccato* (shorter) and *tenuto* (longer) strokes.

D.S. al Coda

'Dal Segno' (go back to the Segno sign), then Coda when you reach 'To Coda', jump to the end.
