Activities

- 1) **Answer** these questions: Which key is this piece in? Which Finger Pattern should you use? What does the Italian term *Cantabile* mean?
- 2) **Clap** through the piece.
- 3) **Check** which top Es are open strings and which are 4th fingers.
- 4) **Look** at the penultimate bar (last but one). The 2 semiquavers attached to a note are known as **grace notes**. These have to be played very quickly at the start of the bar. **Try them out** several times!
- 5) **Play** through with a beautiful, relaxed sound. Be sure to **follow** the dynamics.
