



Waltzing Grizzalo

The Ledger Lines Below the Stave



Here is a piece that is only part written...! It is about a Grizzalo ... an imaginary animal that's a cross between a Grizzly Bear and a Buffalo!

The notes G, A, B and C (on the G string) all use **ledger lines** below the stave. We are going to use just these notes to create a tune on the G string.

Activities

- 1) **Answer** these questions: What is the key of the piece? What is the time signature?
- 2) **Write** the rest of the poem. First, work out how many syllables you want to use.
- 3) **Write** the words under the stave and then work out which order you want to put G, A, B, and C on the stave.
- 4) **Play** what you have written to see what it sounds like. Then try it with a different choice of notes!
