Activities

- 1) **Sing** the song, using the words.
- 2) **Sing** through the piece using letter names. **Shorten** flat notes to one syllable: For Bb say "Beef", for Eb say "Eeef", for Ab say "Aaf"
- 3) **Practise** all the 4th finger Abs and Ebs. Remember to keep using finger pattern 3!
